





#### WILLIAM COGGIN

William Coggin is an artist living and working in Brooklyn, NY. His work consists of ceramic objects, installations, and furniture that are freeform and organic in nature. Functionality has always been a main consideration within his practice, often adapting highly sculptural forms into tables, lamps or mirrors.

His Pseudopodia series consists of forms inspired by the temporary arm-like structures that cells and microorganisms develop in order to feed and move. These lava glaze pieces move beyond traditional inspiration from the natural world by representing phenomena that can only be observed with the aid of technology. Beyond this, William's diverse body of work is a testament to his willingness and ability to explore the ceramic medium in the past and present context, unmoored from current trends or expectations.



#### CHRISTOPHER MASCHINOT

Christopher Maschinot is a New York-based ceramic artist. His interest in clay began at a young age during visits to his uncle's pottery studio and continued through college where he received his BFA in Ceramics at the University of Georgia in 2008. He has been living and working in NYC since 2010.

Working predominantly with handbuilding techniques that utilize both additive and reductive methods, Maschinot creates reliefs, textures, and forms that reference antiquities from a contemporary approach. His meticulous use of pattern and repetition offers a meditation on motifs originating from both natural and constructed forms. Functionality and craftsmanship are at the core of his process, while his pieces convey a sculptural sense of movement, growth, and chaotic order.







#### SCOTT STRICKSTEIN

Scott Daniel Strickstein is a Brooklyn based artist, best known for his innovative ceramic-coated metal mesh that can be sculpted and draped. His studio Scott Daniel Design offers contemporary lighting and furniture celebrated for these highly textural surfaces.

Scott spent much of his youth in Detroit, puzzling over blueprints during visits to construction sites with his father and watching his mother design and create clothing for the apparel industry. While attending Cranbrook High School, he took an elective in ceramics and was immediately fascinated by manipulating a material that could respond to touch. After earning a B.A. in political theory at Michigan State University, he returned to art, receiving his B.F.A. from the College for Creative Studies in Detroit.

Scott Daniel Design launched in NYC in 2010. Inspired by the idea of alchemy, his signature technique balances the inherent imperfections of organic elements with the precision of machined components, all while maintaining an intimate, hands-on approach.


